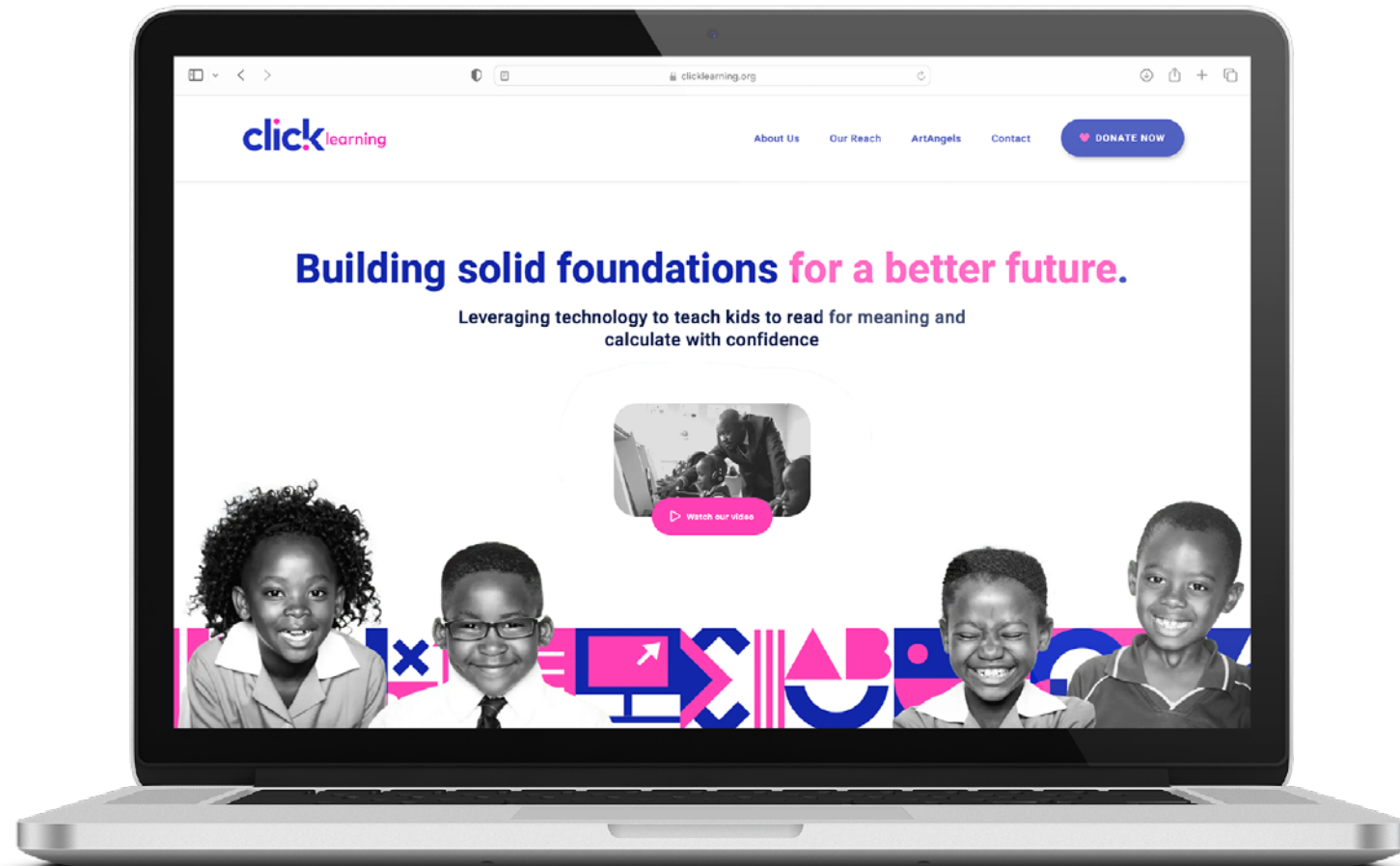

In collaboration with the Bag Factory Artists' Studios, artist Blessing Ngobeni established the Blessing Ngobeni Art Prize. The prize aims to assist young and emerging visual artists (under 35) to launch their careers and we are proud to name them as a beneficiary of ArtAngels again this year.

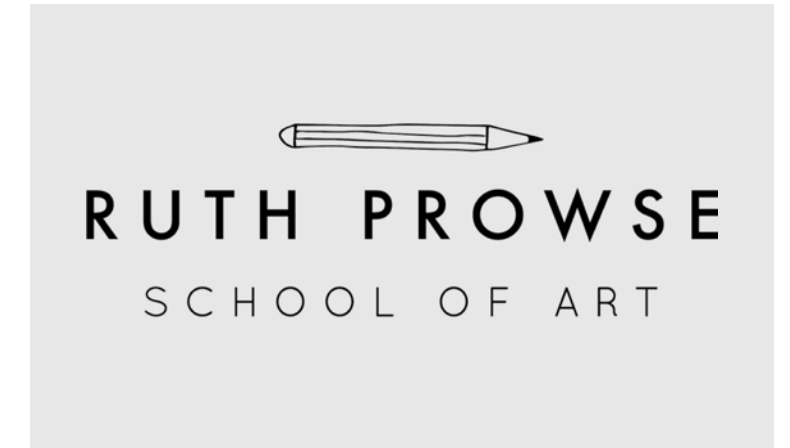
The selected artist is provided with a 12-week studio residency, materials, budget, a stipend and a solo exhibition supported by Everard Read Gallery Johannesburg.

In 2022, ArtAngels sponsored the residency of 27-year-old Boitumelo Motau, the winner of this year's Blessing Ngobeni Art Prize and will re-dedicate our commitment in this regard for the 2023 recipient.



Motau has donated a piece from his first solo exhibition titled, "Inserted Bodies", which will be on auction this evening, while his full installation is currently on showcase at North West University.

Beneficiary / Ruth Prowse School Of Art



The Ruth Prowse School of Art offers a balance between tradition and innovation, striving for excellence in the field of visual communication.

The ArtAngels Everard Read Bursary at RPSA provides financial assistance to the most deserving students as adjudged by Ruth Prowse management and agreed by Everard Read and ArtAngels.

Since inception, the ArtAngels Everard Read Bursary has been awarded to 6 final year students (4 in 2021 and 2 in 2022) and 2 second year students (in 2022). The second year students will receive a further bursary in 2023 should they perform well.

Everard Read has provided mentorship to the current students and we are thrilled to present a work from one of the final year students, Ellyn Pretorius, for tonight's auction.

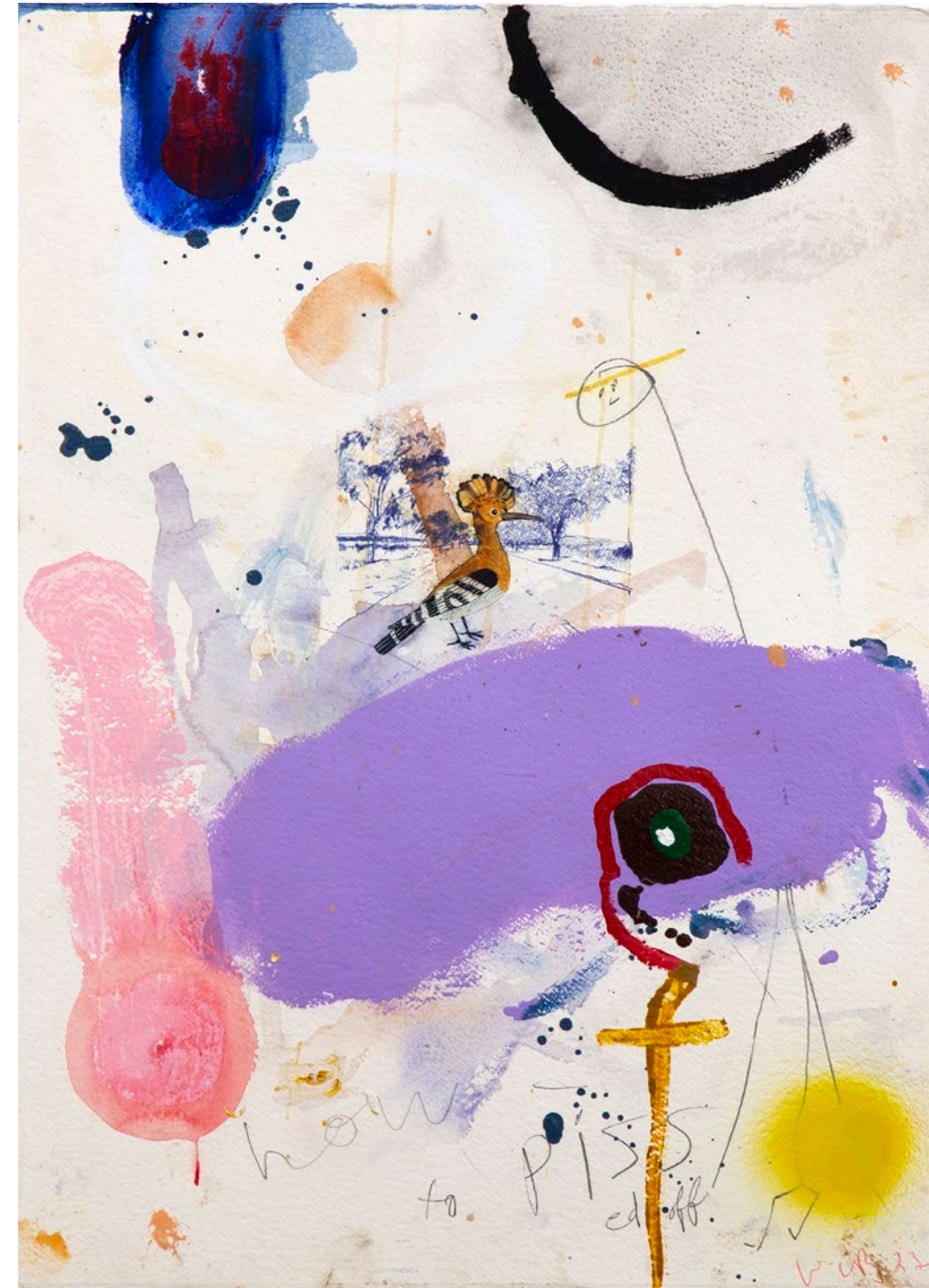

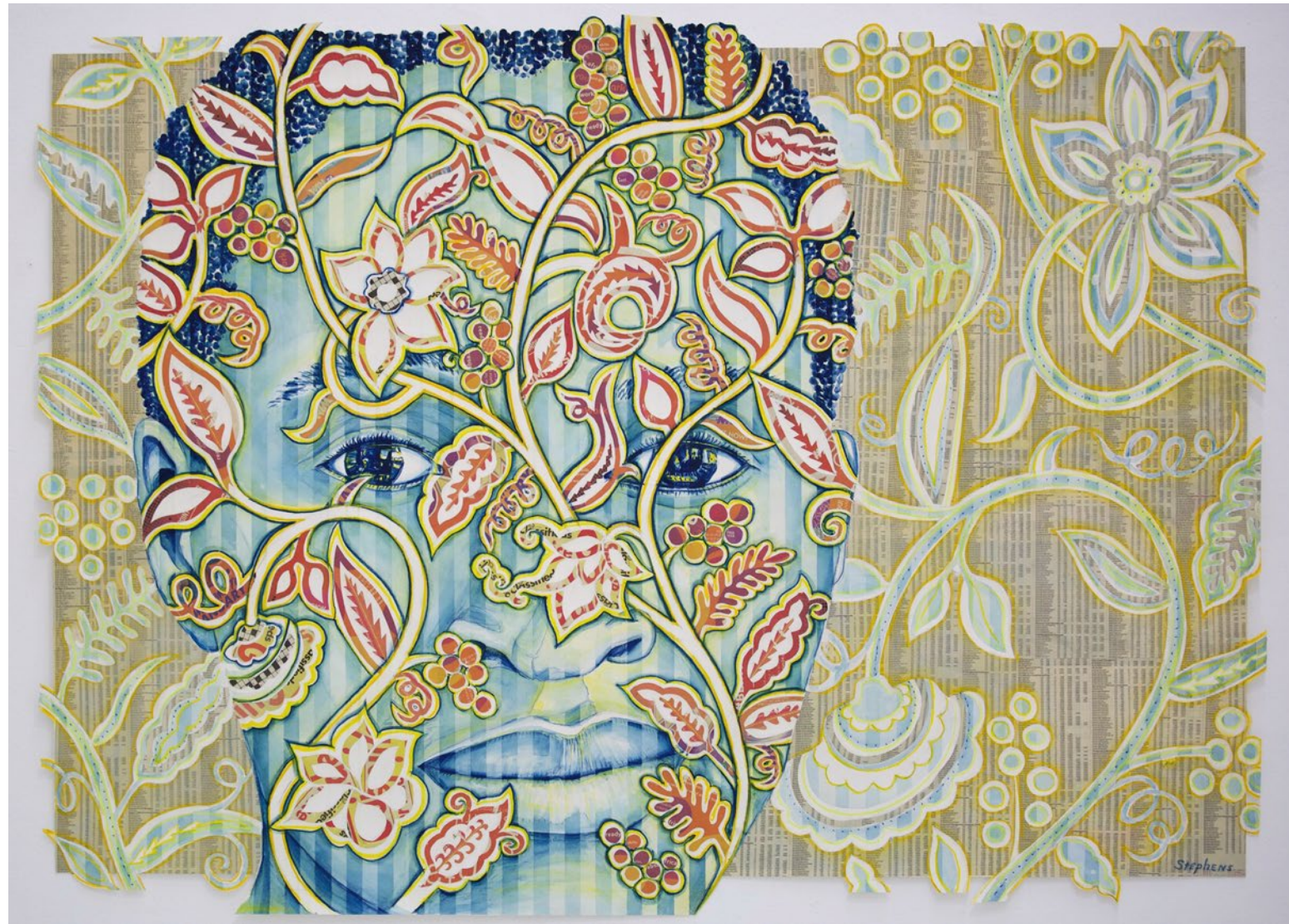

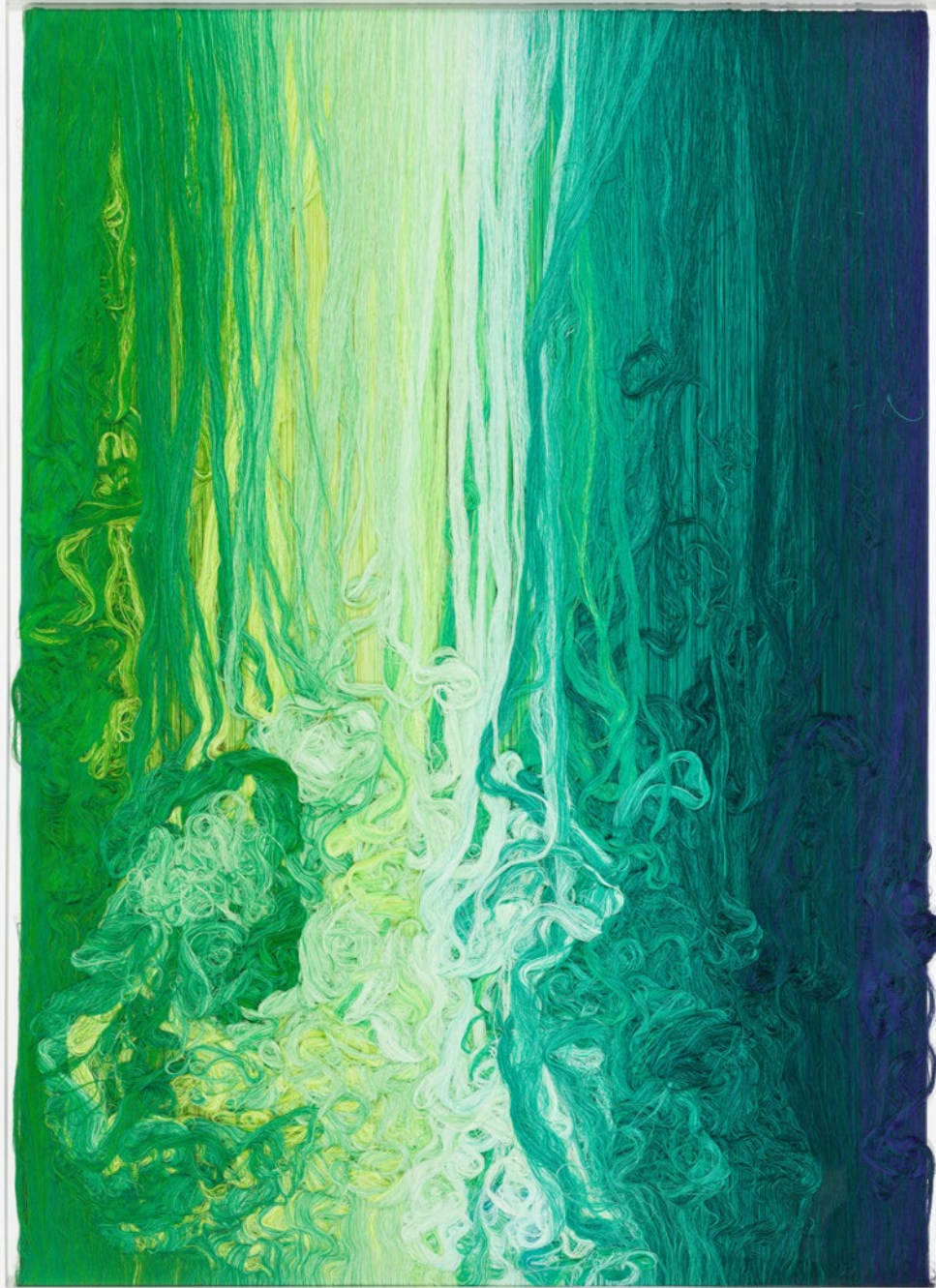

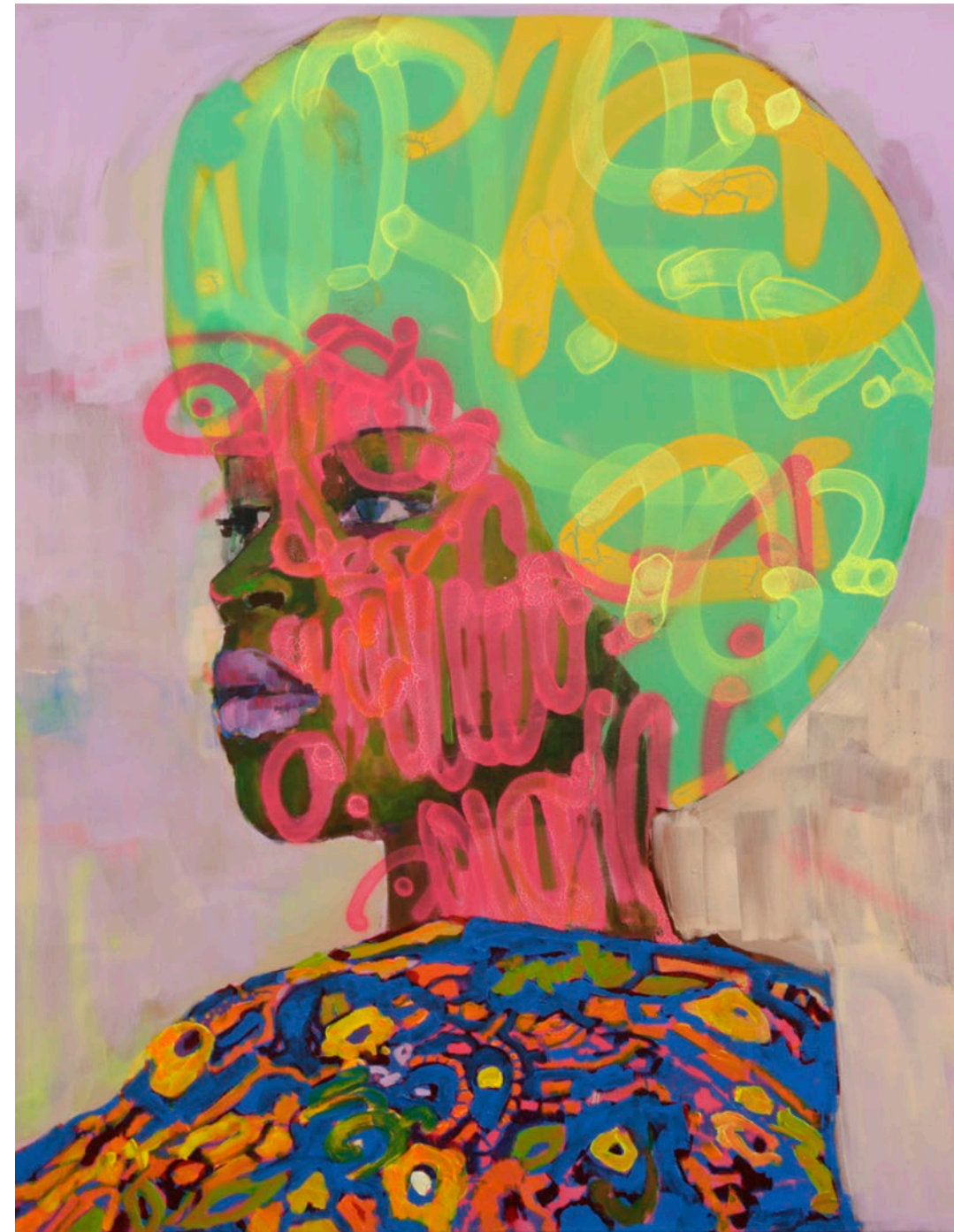
